What is the hosting organization like:

Cultural, sports and tourism center of Suchowola is a place where they carry out tasks in the field of promoting the town. Encouraging reading and culture, as well as the development of tourism, sport and recreation.



Every year there are several events and workshops organized that concern culture, sport and other fields in the community of Suchowola, including ones featuring orchestras, sobriety association, harvest festivals etc.

During the school season the Cultural Center carries out art, dance and music classes for children, led by professional instructors. There is also activities and even a choir for the senior citizens.

Under the wings of the Center there is a wonderful library, which is constantly expanding its collection of currently around 21 000 items.

Where is the project located:

Suchowola is a small town in the north-eastern Poland, with approximately 2 000 inhabitants. It was founded in the 16th century and in 1777 it was granted town rights.

It is a former Polish royal town. In 1775, royal astronomer Szymon Antoni Sobiekrajski published a report in which he stated that Suchowola is the exact geographical center of Europe.

The advantage of the village is its multiculturalism. Here converge the paths of three cultures: Polish, Jewish and Tatar.

Suchowola is a small community, rich in traditions and specific customs.

- participating in the making of cultural events, music festivals, art exhibitions, conferences etc.
